

Congratulations to 2012 National Alumnae of the Year Mr. Thomas Taylor



Thomas Taylor, a native of Phoenix City, Alabama, is the youngest of seven born to Clifford and Inez Taylor. He is a 1983 graduate of Alabama A & M University, where he earned a bachelor's degree in computer science with a minor in Military Science.

One of the original founders of the Washington DC Metropolitan AAMU Alumni Chapter, Taylor is a life member of the AAMU Alumni Association and a strong supporter of Alabama A&M University. He is a past vice-president of the Washington DC Metropolitan Alumni Chapter, past national William Hooper Councill Service Award recipient, and chapter chair of several committees. Recently he chaired the chapter's Endowment Committee. As a result of his leadership, the chapter raised \$30,000 in 18 months which was matched with funds through the University's Office of Advancement for a total chapter endowment of \$60,000.

Taylor is currently co-chairing the "Nu Epsilon Men of Omega" Endowment with AAMU, which he helped to establish. He is instrumental in identifying additional fund raising opportunities for the local chapter and is a member of the team responsible for establishing the Alabama Big 3 (Alabama A&M, Alabama State, and Tuskegee Universities) HBCU WMA Alumni Associations' Annual activities: the Big 3 Gala and Picnic.

Taylor has over 28 years of military and private industry experience. He started his career as a commissioned officer in the United States Army as a Second Lieutenant. He served in the Army at various locations until 1986. Within private industry, he discovered that in addition to his passion for his job in information technology, he has a passion for helping others to succeed. While working at Lockheed Martin, he has been active in recruiting, diversity activities, and employee mentoring.

His affiliations include: life member of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc., and the National Society of Black Engineers (NSBE). He was a Lockheed Martin President's Award winner, a 2005 Black Engineer Modern Day Technology Leadership Award recipient, and he was presented the Lockheed Martin Diversity Award in 2004 and 2008.

Taylor is a strong personal financial contributor to the University. He has given generously to the AAMU Endowment Fund, Marching Maroon & White Band Uniforms, Bulldog Club supporter, 1875 Normalite Campaign, Councill Challenge Endowment, and Washington, DC Scholarship Fund. Taylor is married to Ouida Hampton-Taylor and lives in Gaithersburg, MD. Taylor is the proud parent of one daughter, Kirsten James, and stepson, Marcus Hampton.

Johnny C. Taylor, Jr. President & CEO

Recently named one of the "Power 100" by Ebony Magazine in its 2010-2011 list of the 100 most influential African Americans, Johnny C. Taylor, Jr. is the President & CEO of the Thurgood Marshall College Fund (TMCF), the only national organization representing nearly 300,000 students attending this country's 47 *public* Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs). With approximately 80% of all HBCU students attending TMCF member-schools, Mr. Taylor leads an organization responsible for providing this country a robust and diverse pipeline of talented workers and future leaders.
