All required application materials, including copies of admission's acceptance letter, official school transcript, letter of recommendation, and essay must be submitted by **April 30, 2024,** to:

Award Criteria

- Must be a United States citizen from the Houston Metropolitan Area.
- Must be a graduating high school senior OR a current AAMU undergraduate student who is in good standing with the University
- Must provide evidence of current enrollment at A&M University as a full-time student
- Graduating high school seniors must have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.00 and attained a score in the 50 percentiles on the college entrance examination (ACT or SAT)
- Current AAMU students must have a cumulative GPA of 2.85
- Must demonstrate leadership qualities and involvement in school/community organizations
- Must provide letter of recommendation from a principal, counselor, or teacher and at least one letter from a community leader. Current AAMU students must provide a recommendation letter from advisor, dean, or instructor
- Must also complete essay requirements
- Virtual interview required after scholarship application submission

Essay Criteria

Prepare a minimal 500-word essay that describes you and your career goal incorporating the following questions:

- What is the role of Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs), such as Alabama A & M University in the 21st Century?
- Based on your educational and/or career goals, explain why you decided to attend Alabama A&M University?
- Upon completion of your college degree, how do you plan to improve your community?

Scholarship Application Procedures

- COMPLETE the scholarship application (enclosed)
- Submit a *typed* minimal 500-word essay, doubled spaced with a 12 font that addresses the essay criteria
- REQUEST an official copy of your latest high school or college transcript to be sent to AAMU Houston Alumni Chapter at the above P. O. Box address
- SUBMIT scholarship application, essay, and official copy of your transcript.
- Ensure that the above data is submitted by April 30, 2024
- Include a recent head shot color photo of yourself (4X6)
